6. National Symbols

National Flag of Kwajjää Knögé

The National Flag embodies the **Merkaba of Sovereignty**, encircled by the **labyrinth ring of continuity**, symbolizing eternal covenant and balance between lineage, land, and law. At the four cardinal points stand **ancestral glyphs** — **Ancestor, Breath, Water, and Seed** — representing the elemental foundations of life and the sacred directions of the Amerindian world.

At its center, the **Merkaba star** is **flanked by twin dragons**, guardians of creation and renewal, signifying the Nation's enduring strength and the harmony between terrestrial and celestial realms. The colors — **black, red, blue, and gold** — express earth, blood, sky, and spirit, uniting the realms of existence in sovereign equilibrium.

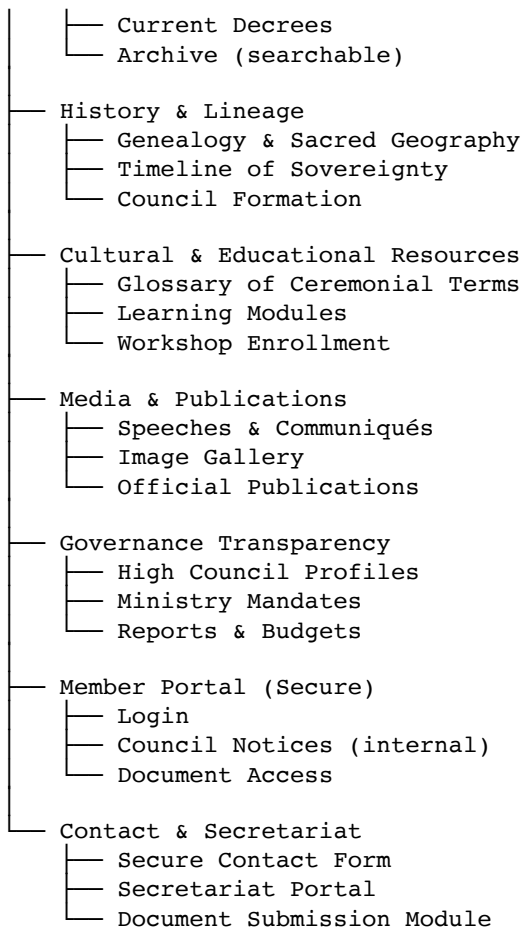
