Red	Bloodline, endurance, ancestral covenant	#8B0000	Dividers, ceremonial highlights, secondary buttons
Blue (Navy)	Sky, guardianship, celestial balance	#003366	Backgrounds, navigation bar
Black	Earth, resilience, continuity of lineage	#000000	Body text, footer, decrees
White	Purity, clarity, ceremonial space	#FFFFFF	Page backgrounds, content areas
Green (Accent)	Renewal, land, restoration	#228B22	Workshop pages, member portal accents

Typography Scheme

Primary Typeface (Headings & Ceremonial Text)

- *Trajan Pro* (or Roman serif equivalent)
- Usage: Article titles, Council decrees, ceremonial headings
- Style: Uppercase, Gold or Navy depending on background

Secondary Typeface (Body Text & Charter)

- *Garamond* (or Georgia for web-safe)
- Usage: Charter articles, membership details, educational resources
- Style: Regular for body, Italic for ceremonial phrases
- Color: Black on White

Accent Typeface (Navigation & Calls to Action)

- *Montserrat* or *Lato* (clean sans-serif)
- Usage: Buttons, navigation links, banners, notices
- Style: Semi-bold / Bold
- Color: Gold or Red depending on emphasis

Application Rules

- **Header/Footer:**
Navy background, gold motto text (“Live True and Die Free”), watermark of the Great Seal.
- **Navigation Bar:**
Black with gold hover highlights.
- **Body Content:**
White background for readability, red dividers for ceremonial emphasis.
- **Buttons:**
Gold primary buttons, red secondary buttons for ritual actions.
- **Symbols Pages:**
Full palette to echo Flag and Coat of Arms.
- **Member Portal:**
Green accents to symbolize renewal and growth.
- **Headings (H1–H3):**
Trajan Pro, uppercase, gold on navy background.
- **Body Text:**
Garamond, 16–18px, black on white.
- **Ceremonial Phrases:**
Garamond Italic, red accent.
- **Footer Motto:**
Trajan Pro, uppercase, gold, centered watermark style.

Design Principle

- **Colours mirror the Flag and Coat of Arms**
→ continuity between symbols and site.
- **Typography balances ceremonial authority with readability**
→ Charter dignity + modern usability.
- **Consistency across all sections**
→ sovereignty expressed in every detail.
